BLAW 3341 Business Law

Credits: 3 (3-0-0)

This course introduces the nature and structure of the US and Texas legal systems; the basic principles of legal reasoning; and laws having as a substantial impact on business including contracts, business organizations, and the Uniform Commercial Code. TSI Restriction(s): Reading, Math, and Writing

Prerequisites: ENGL 1301 and ENGL 1302.

Restrictions: Graduate level students may not enroll.

BLAW 4344 International Business Law

Credits: 3 (3-0-0)

This course introduces comparative law; the nature and structure of international law; international agreement governing dispute resolution, trade, the sale of goods, and direct foreign investment; and the legal risks of international business.

Prerequisites: BLAW 3341 TSI Restriction(s): Reading, Math, and Writing

Restrictions: Graduate level students may not enroll.
