

HONORS (HONR)

HONR 1300 Honors Seminar

Credits: 3 (3-0-0)

This team-taught, interdisciplinary course introduces students to the Honors program and to academic resources offered at the university. The course topic rotates each semester.

Prerequisites: Admission to the Honors program.

Restrictions: Graduate level students may not enroll.

HONR 3300 Advanced Honors Seminar

Credits: 3 (3-0-0)

This advanced, team-taught, interdisciplinary course introduces transfer students to the University Honors program. Continuing Honors students with junior standing who have completed HONR 1300 may enroll with permission. The course topic rotates each semester. (3-0-0)

Prerequisites: Admission to the Honors Program + junior standing at start of semester in which course is offered.

Restrictions: Enrollment limited to students with a semester level of Junior or Senior. Graduate level students may not enroll.

HONR 4000 Honors Capstone

Credits: 0 (0-0-0)

This Honors Capstone is a seminar-style course taken in conjunction with the corresponding capstone course in an Honors student's academic major. Students complete a major research project in their major, engage in periodic reflective writing, and present their work in a professional setting.

Prerequisites: Approval of the Honors Program.

Restrictions: Students with a semester level of Freshman or Sophomore may not enroll. Graduate level students may not enroll.

Repeat Status: Course may be repeated 1 time(s).
