SPCH 1315 Fund of Public Speaking

Credits: 3 (3-0-0)

Introduction to Public Speaking details the history, theory and practice of public speaking with an emphasis placed upon the organization and delivery of informative and persuasive speeches. Further emphasis is given to the reduction of anxieties associated with public speaking. This course meets the standards for the Component Area Option category of course under the core curriculum.

SPCH 1318 Interpersonal Communication

Credits: 3 (3-0-0)

Interpersonal Communication enables students to analyses and practice communication in one-on-one relationships. Students will learn and evaluate basic interpersonal communication theories as well as learn about their personal communication strengths and weaknesses and be given opportunities to improve their communication skills in both individual and group contests. This course meets the standards for the Component Area Option category of course under the core curriculum.
